

AFFIDAVIT

Personally appeared before me, the undersigned Notary Public, in and for said county and state, Glenn McDuffie, who after first being duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

"My name is Glenn L. McDuffie. I reside in Lincoln County, Tennessee. On July 28, 1984, while jogging at the Huntsville High School track, an automobile driven by Richard Hunt attempted to run me down and severely injure or kill me. After the car barely missed me, I immediately obtained the license plate number and wrote it down to insure its correctness. Through this effort I traced the license plate to the name of Ali Shojaee under whom it was registered.

I obtained Shojaee's post office box number and his residence address at the Casa Ben James Apartments at 4525 Judith Lane. The manager of Casa Ben James Apartments told me that Shojaee had given up his apartment and said he was going to Iran. I then wrote Shojaee at his post office box address. (See Exhibit "A" hereto) I received no response and the letter was not returned. I called the manager of the apartments again, and she said she had heard Shojaee had lately been seen in Huntsville and that he had worked as an engineer at Intergraph. I called him there and was connected with his secretary. I told her Glenn McDuffie was calling. She immediately put him on the line, and I hung up without talking to him. That evening he called me at the unlisted number I had given him in the letter. I made an appointment and met with him at his office the following day, September 14. What I learned from him is summarized in my letter of October 5, 1984, to the FBI. (See Exhibit "B" attached hereto)

When I told Shojaee I had worked for the defense part of Westinghouse and had been fired when I blew the whistle on illegal activities, he professed not to even be familiar with the name Westinghouse. His statement simply did not ring true because he had been employed as an engineer in this country for eight years where Westinghouse is a household word. When he was an engineering

student at Iran, Westinghouse was very well known there as the builder and operator of a very large electronics facility to support the Shah's war machine. Many Iranian engineering students were employed there. Later in the meeting he contradicted his previous statement about no knowledge of Westinghouse by warning me I should not oppose as powerful a company as Westinghouse.

Shojaee's trip to Iran conveniently coincided with the month in which my suit had been scheduled for trial. He told me that his brother had been imprisoned by the Ayatullah, but he also said he had no difficulty in entering and leaving Iran. These statements strongly indicate that his brother is being held hostage to insure that Shojaee does the Ayatullah bidding as an Iranian agent in this country. The extent of Khomeini's network of agents in the United States has been investigated and documented by columnist Jack Anderson. (See Exhibit "C" attached hereto)

Shortly after my meeting with Shojaee my wife answered a phone call to the unlisted number I had given in my letter to Shojaee. The male caller had an accent so pronounced she could not understand him, and she hung up. That number was known only to a few close friends and to Shojaee.


I had been fired from Westinghouse due to my disclosure of the illegal shipment of HAWK equipment spare radar parts to Iran. In 1984, shortly after this incident with Shojaee, news accounts began appearing about U.S. customs finding shipments of military equipment going to Iran. I became more and more convinced that the Westinghouse HAWK equipment had gone to Iran. That the administration countenances such activity became very much evident when Secretary of Defense Weinburger squelched further investigation of the F-14 spares which were stolen from the Kitty Hawk and the Miramar Naval Supply Depot and shipped to Iran. I referred to this instance in my letter of July 24, 1985, to Congressman Cooper. (See Exhibit "D" attached hereto)

Ali Shojaee was a conspirator with Westinghouse by and through its employee Richard Hunt in the

attempt on my life. I have enclosed Westinghouse memorandum made while I was employed there from as early as 1979, letters to several congressmen and other persons with contacts in the defense industry, and even a letter to the President, newspaper articles and other documentation which overwhelmingly lead to the fact that the administration is covertly and illegally permitting our military equipment to flow to Iran.

In retrospect we should have realized something was afoot when our hostages in Iran were released at the same time that Reagan was taking the oath of office. Evidently between the time of his election and his inauguration, an agreement had been reached with Khomeini that our government would look the other way when military equipment left our country for delivery to Iran. Ostensibly the reason for such an agreement would have been to maintain the deterrent to a Soviet drive through Iran to the oil producing regions, the same reason why we provided a monumental arms buildup to the Shah. Probably an equally important reason was to permit our intelligence gathering agency to continue electronic surveillance from northern Iran of the Soviet ICBM launch sites in southern Siberia. In my opinion the Soviet Union invaded Afghanistan to deny our establishing similar sites for the same purpose along the northern borders of that country.

Unequivocally, Ali Shojaee is an Iranian agent representing the best interest of the Ayatullah Khomeini in this country. This prompted his conspiracy with Richard Hunt and Westinghouse to cause my death."


