
Dear Agent Harrison:

Rumors persist that the "perfect murder" of Mr. Charles White of the Intergraph Corporation was related to the trucks of that company which ply between Huntsville and Mexico and bring back cocaine on the returns to Huntsville. I suggest that the Iranian national, Mr. Ali Shojaee, was related to this traffic, at least to the extent that our military hardware, specifically the Westinghouse spares, was transferred by this means to Mexico for transshipment to Iran.

In the evidence which I have made available to you, you will note that Mr. Loren Marsh of Westinghouse had the specific responsibility of obtaining the spares from the production line in Baltimore, taking them to his division, the Integrated Logistic Systems Division, located at a considerable distance from Baltimore, and there having them shipped to the designated Army depots. In his sworn answers to an interrogatory, which you have, he listed the many specific dates when he came to Huntsville. I suggest that he brought the spares with him to Huntsville and that they went on the Intergraph trucks to Mexico and thence to Iran.

If you want to question Mr. Shojaee, my private investigator has determined that he is now in the Huntsville area.
